August is a month of few well-known saints.

Dear Friends,

Our Parish is about to see the opening of a new school year. Ten years have already elapsed of this much awaited new century. Families have moved away; others are arriving. During the month of July renovations were made throughout the property. There is no question that the School will continue its journey of excellence according to its Mission Statement.

On August 1st, 1782, the Founder of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate, Eugene de Mazenod was born in Aix-en Provence, a very pretty student town in the South of France. One of the greatest French painters – Paul Cézanne – was also born there. Fr. Mazenod began his Congregation in 1816 as a missionary congregation. He insisted that the month-long parish missions must be preached in Provençal, the local French dialect. The Church was in shambles after the French Revolution. The only way to bring her back on her feet was through parish missions, thought Fr. Mazenod. The Congregation today is present in 65 countries.

August is a month of few well-known saints. Sait Alphonsus de Ligorio, founder of the Order of Preachers. Saint Claire, sister of Francis of Assisi, is celebrated in August, which is also the month of Saint Bernard, a monk founder of Cistercians. Pius X, the first Pope of the 20th century, is remembered in August. A Latin-American woman, Saint Rosa de Lima, is also celebrated in August. The Catholic calendar has in August two well-known saints in the Church history, mother and son, Monica and Augustine.



August is the month of two sorrowful events in Brazilian history for two Presidents: the suicide of Getúlio Vargas and the resignation of Janio Quadros... such is life.

September is the month of Saint Jerome, the first Catholic Bible scholar; John Crisostomo, a fiery preacher, Robert Bellarmine, the initiator of major seminaries in the Church as we know today. We remember Saint Matthew, writer of one of the Gospels and a very important figure in the early Christian communities. September is the month of Saint Vincent de Paul, inspirer of so many different charitable organizations in the Church. And we end the month with the Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, a good way to the spring month.

As the school reopens, Masses will continue to be celebrated on Mondays, Wednesdays at 7:15 a.m. and on Fridays, at 8:15 a.m. according the Mothers & Others calendar.

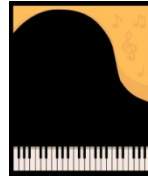
